

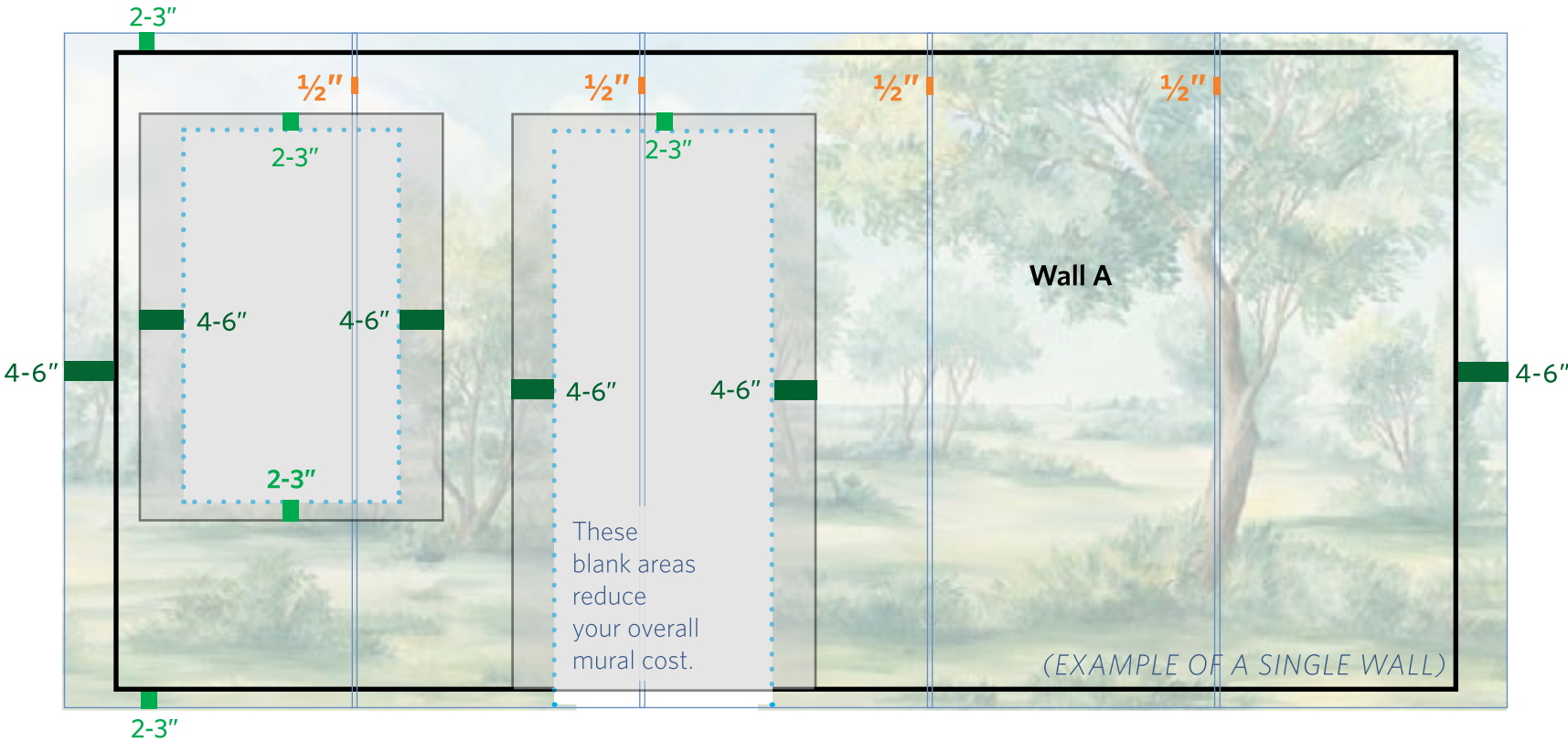

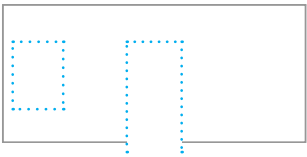

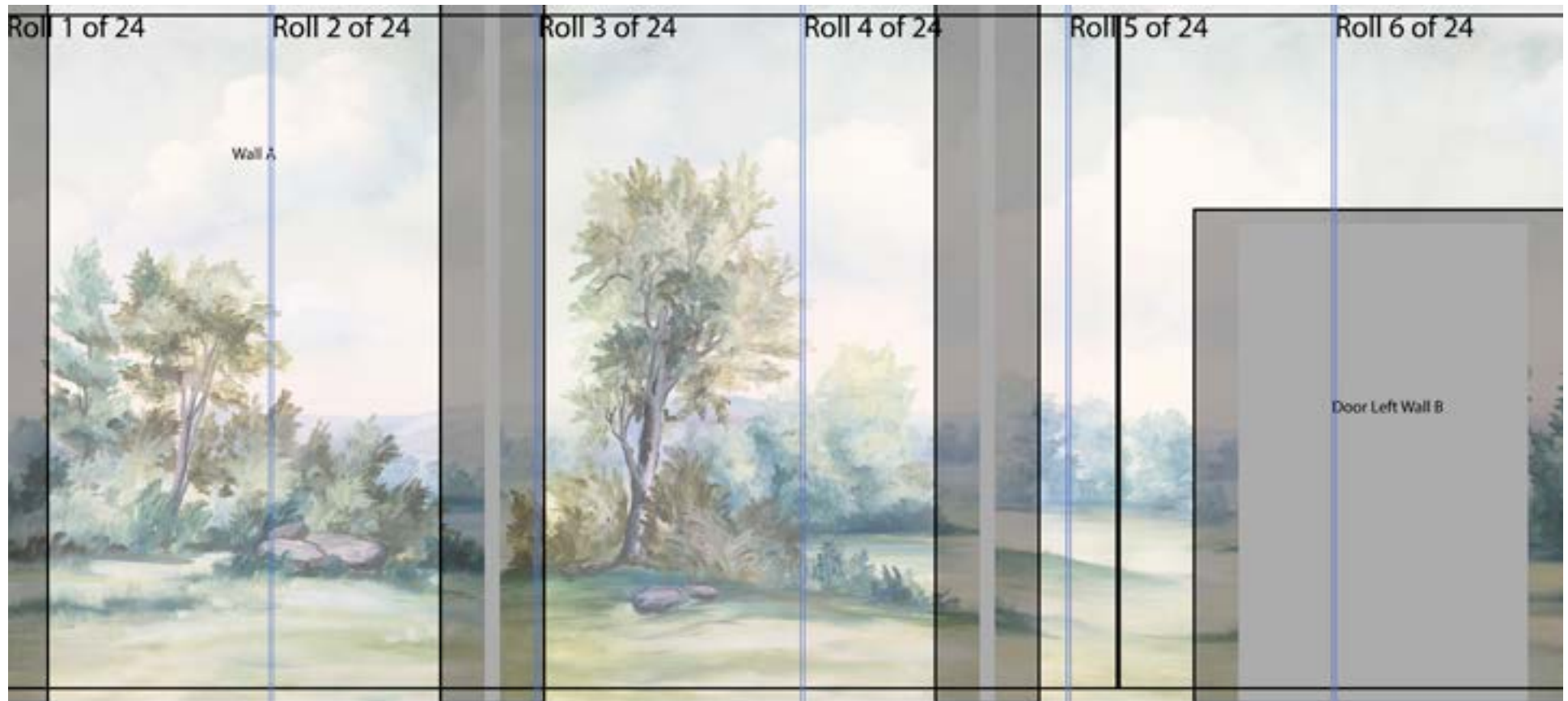
KNOCK-OUT AREAS

- Murals that do not wrap around the entire room have an extra **4-6"** of essential margins on either side of the mural. There are **4-6"** of essential margins on either side of openings (doors, windows, etc.).
- Each roll, with the exception of the overlap between the first and last roll, overlaps by **1/2"**. The following page illustrates the overlap between the first and last roll.
- There are **2-3"** of essential margins on the top and bottom of the mural.

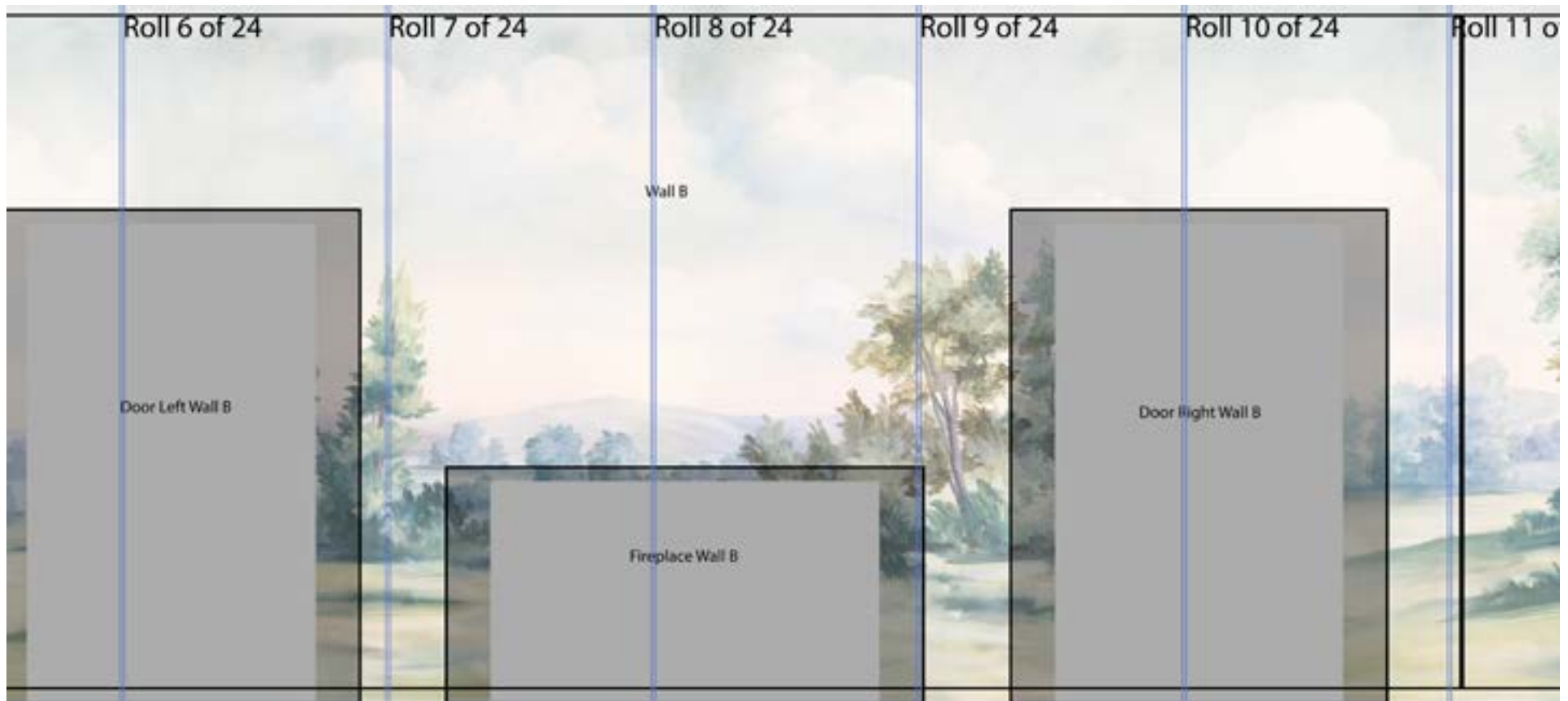
- Measurements are client-provided and should be checked against as-builts to spot issues before you cut. If measurements given to us were correct, then:
- We print blanks for doors and windows to allow for a one-of-a-kind layout. We do not charge the clients for these door and windows areas, to help them save on costs. You'll need to line these blank areas up carefully so they land in the right place.
- 6" inches of horizontal margin material is on the left and right ends of the mural, and within each door and window blank. That lets you adjust the mural a bit, side-to-side.
- 2"-3" inches of vertical margin material on both top and bottom is provided to help with uneven walls. Let the goods set up, pasted, on the wall before you trim (there is a tiny amount of vertical shrinkage and no known horizontal shrinkage).
- The panels usually trim to 35" wide. We sometimes make narrow panels to help avoid awkward seams. If your job has narrow panels, we'll list them below.

PRO TIPS:

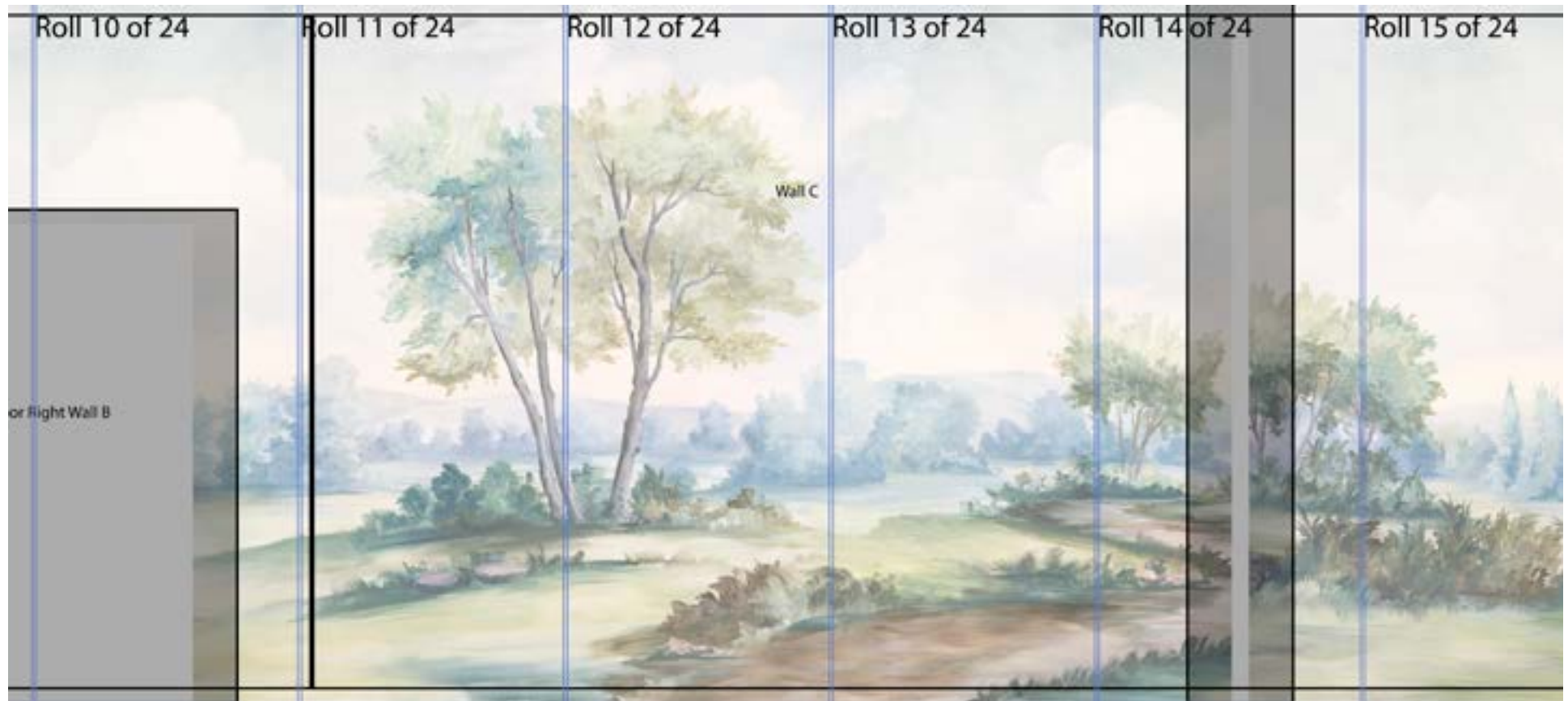
- Penciling in your seam placements helps you make sure all the goods will fit before you start cutting and placing them.
- ***THE PANELS SHOWING SKY ARE NOT PRINTED AS A SOLID COLOR.*** They vary throughout the mural on purpose. Please install them in numerical order, or they will look patchy.

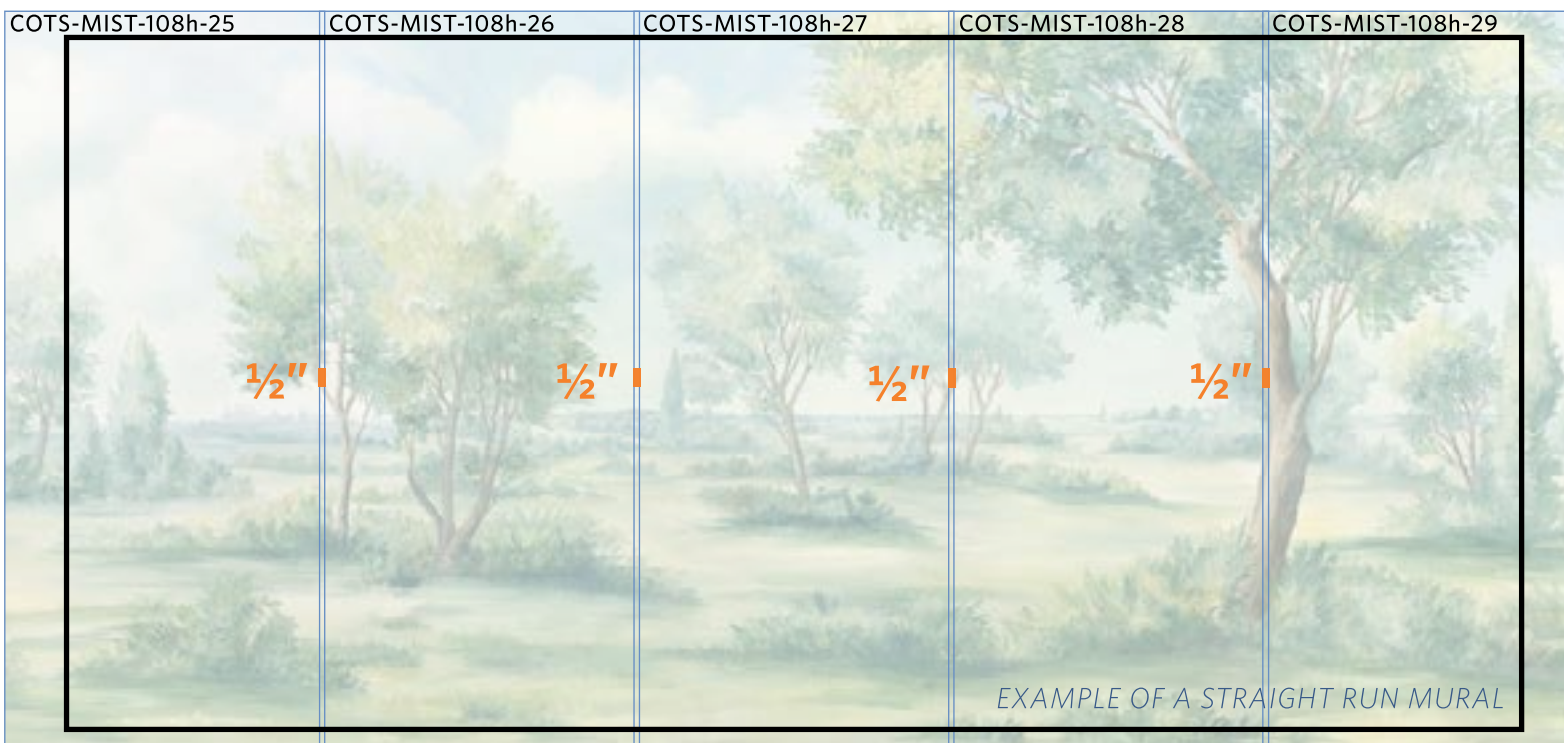

Example of Roll Overlaps and Essential Margins in a Straight Run Mural

- Each roll overlaps by $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- We aim to provide **2"** or more of essential margins on both the top and bottom of the mural, and double that on the sides. Specific amounts may vary significantly depending on the client's wall dimensions.
- Each roll has a unique label, for example: COTS-MIST-108H-25. See following page for how to read roll labels.

General Notes

- Please note, all the rolls are numbered, and should be hung in order.
- The client chose these rolls from a much larger set of pre-numbered rolls available at this height. For example, they might have been offered 60 rolls, and only needed five rolls. They were allowed to chose rolls from anywhere in the set, as long as they were in order. So they may have chosen rolls 1-5, or 15-20, or 37-42, etc. **Please start with the lowest number you have, and work left to right on the wall.**
- The mural is untrimmed. The vertical trim lines are marked. There is a small overlap of the artwork between each panel, allowing you the option of making a double-cut on the wall.
- You can expect to have between 2-4" of margin material on the top and bottom. Please measure the overall roll before you begin and compare it to your tallest wall height. We advise you to trim the top and bottom after the mural is on the wall and has set up for a bit.
- **Please measure your overall wall width before starting.** Each trimmed roll of goods is approx. 35" wide. Count your rolls before starting and multiply by 35", to make sure you have enough goods to span the whole wall.

How to Read Roll Labels

COTS-MIST-108h-25

This code is for instructional purposes only and may not represent your particular mural, colorway, height, or roll selection.

COTS: Mural name

MIST: Colorway

108h: 108" high. Indicates a general upper limit for suitable wall heights.

25: Roll number (see General Notes for more on roll numbers)

Notes For This Mural

- Sky color varies throughout mural, please hang all panels in sequence.
- Your mural is 108 inches tall (the amount of the actual mural's height).
